Piaget & Vygotsky Theories

EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT

Early Childhood Education is no longer seen as a luxury for the rich, it is an important part of a child's development. Piaget who identified Cognitive Development Theory and Vygotsky who identified Social Learning Theory. Given our understanding of ECE in the last 50 years we urge all parents to give consideration to an organized preschool program that empasizes early literacy, social development, and creativity.



Vygotsky's Social Development Theory

Vygotsky's theories stress the fundamental role of social interaction in the development of cognition (Vygotsky, 1978), as he believed strongly that community plays a central role in the process of "making meaning."

Piaget's Stages of Cognitive Development

STAGES	AGE RANGE	DESCRIPTION
Sensorimotor	From birth to 2 years	 Identifies object performance, the object still exists when out of sight Recognition of ability to control object and acts intentionally
Preoperational	2 to 7 years	 Begins to use language Egocentric thinking difficulty seeing things from other viewpoints Classified objects by single feature i.e. color
Concrete Operational	7 to 11 years	 Logical thinking Recognizes conservation of numbers, mass and weight Classifies objects by several features and can place them in order
Formal Operational	11 years and onward	 Logical thinking about abstract propositions Concerned with the hyphothetical and the future Create hypotheses and test

International Kindergarten

Ages 5 to 6

The goal in kindergarten is to establish a level of academic skills and understanding that will be the foundation for future success in primary school and beyond.

KINDERGARTEN PHONICS

Students begin the reading journey using the blending of phonetic sounds. Phonetic skills are further reinforced in the learning process as writing/composition skills are introduced, vocabulary is developed, and spelling is emphasized.

KINDERGARTEN MATHEMATICS

The mathematics skills of the children are taken to the next level of difficulty, continuing the number concepts learned in the pre-kindergarten programs. The students in the bilingual program typically enter Grade 1 able to read, write, and speak in two languages.

NURSERY PHONICS

MATHEMATICS FOR NURSERY

Nursery education is the very beginning of learning how to learn. Attention is paid to delivering what is developmentally appropriate for each child in a supportive manner. Beginning mathematics and language skills are presented with no "pressure to perform." This is when learning is fun. Emphasis is on developing vocabulary for all domains.

Children are introduced to building early reading and writing skills while building vocabulary. Problem-solving is introduced including concepts relating to numbers, shapes, colors and mathematics. Various teaching styles are employed to encourage curiosity and to develop life skills and problem-solving.
